

Saint of the Day:

Saint Nikephoros the Confessor, Patriarch of Constantinople

Commemorated on June 2

Saint Nikephoros (Nikephóros) was a dignitary at the court of the Empress Irene (797-802). After embracing monasticism, he became widely known for his piety. He assumed the Patriarchal Throne of Constantinople in 806 and became a zealous defender of the holy Icons. In 815, the Iconoclast Emperor Leo the Armenian



(813-820) exiled him to Prokonnis, where he fell asleep in the Lord in 828.

Saint Nikephoros left behind three writings against Iconoclasm.

In 846, the relics of Patriarch Nikephoros were returned to Constantinople and placed in the Great Church of Hagia Sophia for one day before being transferred to and enshrined in the Church of the Holy Apostles.

If the Fire Alarm went off in our Church, would you know what to do?

The answer is, calmly and quickly remove yourself and any people needing assistance from the building through the nearest exit and then go to the "Muster Point". Simple.

The "Muster Point" is a spot outside where people meet in the case of Emergency so that they are safely away from the building and not in the way of the Emergency responders. In our case the Muster Point is at the back of our parking lot. We can not meet at the front of the Parking Lot as that is where the Fire Trucks will need to enter and hook up to the hydrant.

Please be familiar with the locations of all the fire exits, pull stations and fire extinguishers by looking at the maps posted in various locations within the building. These maps are also found on this bulletin below for your convenience today.

If you discover a fire in the building and it is possible to put out, extinguish it.


If you discover a fire that is not manageable, immediately pull the nearest fire Pull Station, then exit the building. If you are the last person exiting then close doors behind you.

What to do for a fire drill?

Treat the event like a real fire. Immediately exit through the nearest exit and go to the muster point.

When will we have a fire drill?

We are planning to have one soon... but the timing will be a surprise.
