Many of you have been asking, so here is a brief report on what I did in August while I was away.

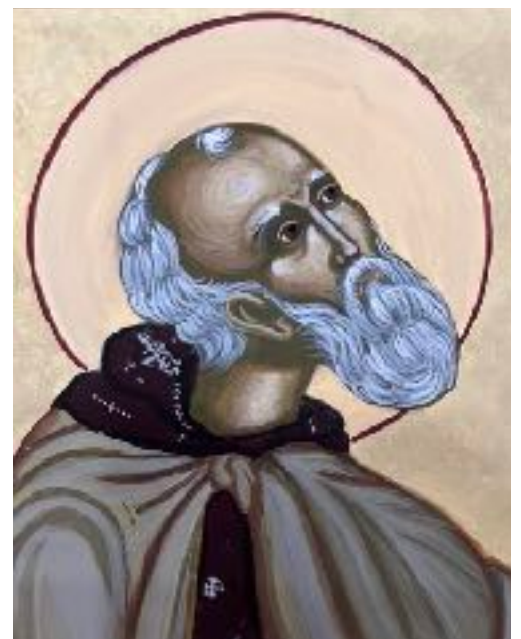
I took three weeks of holidays to go to school in Crete (Greece). As many of you know, I have been painting/writing traditional Icons for about 30 years. Bishop David agreed to let me expand my knowledge by participating in the "Writing the Light" Iconography Program with Dr. George Kordis, one of the worlds better known Master Iconographers. During the 10 days of a Workshop we wrote icons of St. Maximos the Confessor, the Miracle of St. Michael the Archangel and the icon of the Transfiguration.

In addition to the workshop, I had the opportunity to study many traditionally painted Greek Churches (Ukrainian Catholics are Greek Catholics too) that were built and painted over the centuries. It was a very enlightening trip.

One more thing that I must say: I appreciate Alberta's dry summer weather more than that of Greece. It was hot and humid.

Thank you to all who prayed for me as I was traveling and also thank you to all those who kept the parish's "home fires burning".
